



SPIMEX launched trading in liquid nitrogen fertilizers

On 9 November 2021, the first trades in UAN-32 liquid nitrogen fertilizer were effected in the SPIMEX Mineral Raw and Chemical Products Section. Two contracts for physical delivery of 800 tonnes were made.

Fertilizers were sold at Druzhny delivery point located in the Krasnodar Krai in the south of Russia. Each lot amounts to 25 mt with delivery on ex-works with loading onto trucks basis.

As of today, all major types of mineral fertilizers are traded on SPIMEX: ammonium nitrate, urea, ammophos and sulfoammophos, diammonium phosphate, diammophoska, azophoska (nitroammophoska), liquid complex fertilizer etc.

Mineral fertilizers are traded on the Exchange at more than 200 delivery points located in 45 constituent regions of Russia.

Today, the largest domestic producers of mineral fertilizers offer their products at the exchange trading: PhosAgro Group (JSC Apatit, LLC PhosAgro-Region), JSC MCC EuroChem (LLC EuroChem Trading Rus), URALCHEM JSC (Trading House URALCHEM LLC), Acron Group (PJSC Acron, PJSC Dorogobuzh, JSC Agronova), KuibyshevAzot PJSC, PJSC Togliattiazot, JSC SDS Azot (KAO Azot, JSC Ammony, Meleuz Mineral Fertilizers JSC), LLC Gazprom neftekhim Salavat, Minudobreniya JSC, Rossosh (Rossoshanskiy Agrottrade LLC). Sections of the Exchange where physical delivery is made by rail.
