



SPIMEX launched trading in aquatic biological resources (fish products)

On 30 March 2021, the Saint Petersburg International Mercantile Exchange (SPIMEX) launched exchange trading in aquatic biological resources (fish products).

Commencing trades in a new asset class, the Exchange scales up its accumulated experience extending it to new commodity markets and introducing modern digital technologies in the area of trade and transparent pricing.

The first product sold on SPIMEX was frozen pollock. The designated delivery point is a warehouse located in Vladivostok operated by JSC VSFP company.

The Saint Petersburg International Mercantile Exchange (SPIMEX) is Russia's largest commodity exchange offering a wide range of products traded both in its Commodities Section (refined oil products, crude oil, natural gas, LPG, timber and construction materials, fertilizers) and in its Derivatives Section.
